Ornamental plants & seedlings

Below are the drafted rules to add to the SFM Rules & Regulations document concerning the sale of plants and seedlings at the market. If you have any comments, please pass them on to me, as these will be adopted at the May committee meeting. Numbering to be added later.

To be added to the DEFINITIONS section:

PLANT AND PLANT PRODUCTS

Cut flowers, plants, seeds and seedlings of any type.

To be added to the ADDITIONAL RULES FOR PRIMARY PRODUCERS section:

SPECIAL RULES FOR PRODUCERS OF PLANTS AND PLANT PRODUCTS

All plant and plant products must be harvested, germinated, propagated or otherwise cultivated on the producer's own land or place of enterprise within the local region.

Any species identified as a weed by a Local Council in any of the Local Government Areas within the local region are not permitted to be sold.
